



























































DINOSAUR MATCHING GAME

Match the name to the correct dinosaur. An answer sheet is provided with the named dinosaurs if required.

Here is some information to help you make the correct match:

Allosaurus: Had 3 fingers on their arms. They had a huge skull. They were balanced by a large heavy tail.

Brachiosaurus: Long neck. Short body. Front legs longer than back legs.

Diplodocus: Long neck to reach food. Small head and very long body.

Iguanodon: Their thumbs had spikes on top to help them stab food. Crawled on all fours as arms just 25% shorter than their legs. Small head.

Microraptor: Feathered on all 4 limbs. Bird like head.

Spinosaurus: Large spines which grew to about 1.65m (5.4 ft). Long arms.

Triceratops: Had long horns of solid bone for defence. They had a bony frill to protect their necks and a sharp parrot like beak.

Stegosaurus: Had large bony plates on its back. Walked on four legs. Had a spiked tail. Short neck.

Tyrannosaurus Rex: Had a large head and tiny arms. Powerful back legs.

Velociraptor: Long back legs used for running. Long sharp claws for ripping flesh. Lots of sharp pointed teeth.
