**Some ideas for simple art and craft activities:**

**Potato printing**

**cut smallish potatoes (perfect for little hands to grip) in half and pat dry with kitchen towel. Draw a simple fish design onto the flat edge of the potato and use a sharp knife to carve out the outline. Help your child to dip the potato into some washable paint and start printing! You can wipe off excess paint with kitchen towel. Why not introduce colour mixing with your child?**

**Ocean in a jar**

**pour a layer of sand into a large jar (with lid). Pop in a few shells and any small plastic fish or sea creatures that (e.g. toy fish, dolphin, crab) you have and fill the jar with water. Add a couple of drops of blue and green food colouring then pop the lid on, tighten and seal with tape so that your little one can't open it!**

**Seashell imprints**

**use shells of different and shapes and sizes to make imprints into playdough**

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## Sponge painting

**cut unused cleaning or bath sponges into sea creature shapes – starfish, dolphin, fish – and print with them using washable paint. Create an underwater scene!**
